August Free Animal Distant Healing

Throughout this month on Sunday evenings from 8pm to 8.30pm a team of our volunteers have been sending distant healing to any animals nominated to receive it. Now in its third year, this activity is becoming increasingly popular and on the last Sunday in August alone, we sent Reiki to 40 animals - cats, dogs, donkeys and horses. We've received some lovely feedback from grateful carers of a number of the animals and we look forward to receiving more feedback. We will offer this service again in February 2020.

Reiki can help all types of animals

Two of our volunteers, David Wood and Maria Guimaraes, on a holiday to Thailand offered Reiki to elephants that had previously led a working life and were now cared for in a sanctuary.

David and Maria were led with the elephants, to a bathing pool where they bathed with, and washed, a magnificent 40year old female elephant.

They intended Reiki to flow as they laid their hands on her back, gently stroking and scrubbing her. The elephant quickly closed her eyes and relaxed, glancing occasionally to see where our volunteers were, then settling back to eyes closed and relaxed.
